New Business Attraction

In FY 22, the Greater San Marcos Partnership submitted for 6 projects on behalf of the City of Lockhart, representing a conservative estimate of 600 new jobs and \$183M in new capital expense investment.



Business Retention & Expansion

Additionally, during FY 2022, GSMP took on business retention & expansion efforts with **5** different employers in the city of Lockhart.

GSMP also facilitated growth in the manufacturing sector through collaboration with local manufacturers in the Greater San Marcos Manufacturing Association (GSMMA).



Key Developments & Results in Lockhart

- ★ Aided in the development and expansion of Iron Ox (a robotics-powered produce grower), resulting in \$120 million in new capital investment and the county's first-ever 1M sq ft facility.
- Collaborated to recruit and attract location announcement from The Ziegenfelder Company (a frozen foods manufacturer), representing 100 jobs and \$29 million in new capital investment.
- Reviewed & developed new workforce training curriculum and opportunities for exiting inmates at Lockhart Corrections Facility.
- Showcased SH 130 through featured interviews and national media publicity with stories in Government Tech, downtown quality of life efforts in The Business Journals, expansion projects such as Iron Ox in CNBC, and others.
- * Convened all region's city managers to Lockhart, including Lockhart city manager Steve Lewis, for meetings with six national site consultants on 2022 Texas Innovation Corridor Familiarization Tour.
